

## KINTAMANI TOUR



Enjoy spectacular views of Mount Batur, with ribbons of dried black lava running down from its peak into a valley below. Stop at the Lake View Hotel for a coffee break to view the scenery in comfort. Travel on to see the stunning Tegallalang rice terraces, a national heritage site.

Visit the Goa Gajah elephant cave which dates from the 11th century, or the spectacular Monkey Forest temple in the heart of Ubud village. Lunch at our secret chosen restaurant called Indus overlooking the Ayung River. Visit the Ubud Markets or one of the traditional artist villages where they specialize in silver, painting or woodcarving.

#### **TOHPATI**

Tohpati Village is the centre of batik manufacture in Bali and it's very exciting to watch the Balinese design the cloth. It's not just simple structured paintings – these people are very skillful. Follow the whole process production, waxing and weaving and



#### **BATUBULAN**

Stone carving has a long tradition here, and the qualities of the products are very good. From young boys to old men, they all seem to be experts in stone carving here. The material used is mainly paras stone, grey volcanic stone or soapstone. It's no problem to stop by a stone carver and watch the workers do their work in the shadows under large trees.



#### **CELUK**

Celuk Village is the famous village in Bali as a tourist destination because the local residents are very proactive and full of innovation in the gold and silver crafting. This countryside is located in Sukawati, Gianyar Regency and has individuality and excellence in production of gold and silver crafting. Most of the workers are Balinese professionals, who are artistic and skillful in the design development related to silver and gold design.



#### **ELEPHANT CAVE**

The holy site of Goa Gajah (Elephant Cave) is extremely important to Balinese Hindus and is well worth a visit. It is located in Gianyar Regency about 27 km from Denpasar, and has been formed by the confluence of two major rivers; the Pangkung and the Petanu.



#### **PLANTATION VISIT**

Visit a plantation that grows coffee, cacao, ginseng and lemon grass. They also make the infamous kopi luwak, coffee beans that are eaten by civet cats and then collected again from the feces for a better taste. You will be invited to see the processing and taste the different sorts of coffee, cacao and tea. The ginseng coffee is also very good and has a good effect on the body.



### **KINTAMANI**

Kintamani is one of the best tourist destinations in Bali with the active volcano of Mount Batur and a beautiful crater lake. Kintamani is surrounded by captivating nature and there are six ancient Bali Aga villages within the caldera of Batur Lake, the earliest inhabitants of Bali, who have a unique culture and lifestyle.



### **TEGALLALANG – RICE TERRACE**

Some of the most spectacular rice field terraces are found in Tegallalang, just 15 minutes outside of Ubud. The surrounding gorge has attracted many photographers over the years who have come to capture these timeless images.



### **UBUD MARKET**

Ubud Traditional Art Market is the economic centre of Ubud and it is opposite to the existence of Ubud Empire that is called Puri Saren. The market is unfolding from west to east divided become two group with different purpose. There are two markets available at the same area those are one block at the Westside is for a traditional artistic market and another block located in the east as an everyday traditional fundamental market requirement.

## TANAH LOT TOUR



After leaving Seminyak, stop first at Taman Ayun in Mengwi, an important temple complex for Bali's Hindu population. Located on ground level with a wide moat surrounding it, then a further 25 minutes drive to Alas Kedaton to visit a temple surrounded by an overgrown monkey forest, always a favorite with Tourists.

Hold on to your sunglasses and keep your camera handy for lovely pictures. Lastly Tanah Lot, Bali's most important coastal temple. Built in the 16th century on a huge rock outcrop in the sea. At low tide it is possible to walk up to the temple. Enjoy stunning sunsets across the blue ocean from the mainland.

### **CANGGU**

Canggu has the lush green rice terraces and spectacular views of the Indian Ocean this area would have to be classed as untouched and offers a quiet and relaxed atmosphere. Many holiday villas built with a blend view of rice terrace and ocean.



### **TAMAN AYUN**

Taman Ayun Temple is a Royal Temple of Mengwi Empire and it is located in Mengwi Village, Mengwi sub district, Badung regency and about 18 Km north side of Denpasar town. It is strategically located beside of major roadway between Denpasar to Singaraja. It is set on the land, which is surrounded by the big fish pond and look like a drift on the water. It owns the beautiful temple building with multistoried roof and Balinese Architecture. The wide beautiful landscape garden in front courtyard to welcome all visitors who come and visit this temple. It is a beautiful place to visit on your vacation in Bali.



### **ALAS KEDATON**

Alas Kedaton is a small forest with the width about 6-7ha located in the middle of the rice field in Tabanan regency, west part of Bali. The total size of this forest, temple and its supporter facility is about 12 ha. In this forest, there is a temple called Alas Kedaton Temple and owns the natural environments that is looked green with its fresh air and create the calm, quite and holy atmosphere.



### **TANAH LOT**

Tanah Lot Temple is located in coastal side of Beraban countryside, Kediri sub district and Tabanan Regency. It is situated in 30 Km in west side of Denpasar town and about 11 Km in south side of Tabanan town. The temple is built on the rock with 3 acre size and reachable in a few minutes walk, because it is just 20 meters from the coastal lip. This temple is very famous among tourist destinations in Bali with spectacular view of sunset.

## DENPASAR CITY TOUR



Visit Bali's main Museum in Denpasar, with a splendid collection of artifacts from prehistoric times until today. Then on to the Arts Centre a traditional Balinese building which houses a permanent exhibition of modern paintings with some of the best Bali art to be found there.

Finally to the local Kumbasari local market where all kinds of arts, crafts, produce and almost anything that one can find in Bali is sold.

### **KUMBASARI – TRADITIONAL MARKET**

This traditional, non-air-conditioned market offers an interesting overview of an Indonesia market. In the basement, you will find the traditional market and lots of traditional kitchen crafts made out of woven bamboo on the first floor. The second floor provides spices and dried goods as well as a wide variety of Balinese printed batik, Balinese and Javanese hand-woven textiles and various batik textiles at reasonable prices, while the household wares and clothing can be found on the third floor.



### **BIRD & ANIMAL MARKET**

PasarBurung (Bird Market) is located on Jl. Pramuka, Denpasar. This colorful and noisy market provides a wide range of birds and other such small animals as monkeys, squirrels, small wild cats and other unidentifiable animals from the heart of the dark jungles of Indonesia.



### **BALI MUSEUM**

Bali Museum is strategically located in Major Wisnu Street in Denpasar Bali and it is find it due to the location is in the heart town. In the north side there are glorious temple of Jagatnatha, meanwhile in front of it the Puputan Badung (Badung Courtyard) and four-faced statue (CaturMuka Statue) are located. The development of Bali Museum is begun by the existence of initiative how to vitally the heritage of Balinese culture and taking care of, preserve and maintaining.



### **ART CENTRE**

Art Centre which is Iso called Taman WerdiBudaya, the Art Center is on Jalan Nusa Indah in Abiankapas, a suburb of Denpasar in the direction of Sanur, only a 15-minute walk east of Kreneng station. Set in a restful garden with lotus ponds amid richly carved baroque Balinese buildings, the Taman WerdiBudaya houses exhibits of modern painting, masks, and woodcarving. Both Balinese and Indonesian artists are featured. You'll find a car park, museum, and small, fixed-price handicraft shops.

## ULUWATU TOUR



Visit the massive Garuda Wisnu Kencana Park on the way to view the massive statue and views of Bali from one of its high points. Uluwatu is a stunning temple found on the spectacular cliff edge at the southern most point of Bali. Also a popular haven for Bali's surfing crowd.

Enjoy the Kecak dance performed by 50 bare chested men dancing the traditional battle dance at the temple. Some great picture opportunities here. Stop at Jimbaran bay to eat seafood on the beach at Menega Cafe and enjoy dining under the stars.

### **NUSA DUA BEACH**

Nusa Dua is well known as an elite resort area and it own the beautiful white sandy beach with calm and warm seawater. The carpets of white sand along to coastal with coconut trees are planted that is ideally for day relaxation in Bali. It is one of the fascinations for tourist to come and enjoy the holiday in this place. The luxury five star hotels have been built along the coastal to complete this area as a first class tourist places in Bali.



### **SURFING VILLAGE**

Padang – Padang Beach is a famous surf point in Bali with the great waves and white sandy stretch 100 meters from the north to the south. This surf point is situated the white stone hill with nature scenery to the Indian Ocean and spectacular sunset at late afternoon that creates the romantic nuance.



### **ULUWATU TEMPLE**

Uluwatu Temple is one of Bali's kayanganjagat (directional temples) and guards Bali from evil spirits from the SW, in which dwell major deities, in Uluwatu's case; BhataraRudra, God of the elements and of cosmic force majeure. Bali's most spectacular temples located high on a cliff top at the edge of a plateau 250 feet above the waves of the Indian Ocean. Uluwatu lies at the southern tip of Bali in Badung Regency.



### **JIMBARAN BAY**

Jimbaran Beach is directly south of the airport, on the way from Denpasar towards Nusa Dua. Jimbaran village is the narrow neck of Bali Island, and thus it has two remarkably different beaches. On the west, Jimbaran Beach faces the Jimbaran Bay, recently lined by new luxurious resorts. On the east, the beach faces the body of water sheltered by Benoa Harbor. Jimbaran is a sleepy cove where fleets of fishing boats color the scene.

## JATILUWIH TOUR



Jatiluwih Tour is the exciting tour to visit places of interest like Batukaru Temple and Rice Terrace Jatiluwih. They are located in the fertile volcanic foothills of the Batukaru Mountains, you will see and abundance of tropical fruit, spices, coffee, vegetables and flowers. It is no wonders that the community here is considered Bali's farming elite. For the Balinese, cultivation of land is a creative art and a communal effort, and the people of Jatiluwih have created a true masterpiece- an endless and intricate jigsaw of finely-curved rice terraces in brilliant shades of green, with glistening waters, and beautiful rice terrace in theJatiluwih countryside. There are some temple building spread out through the tranquility of rain forest and the big mountain of Batukaru as a back drop.



### **JATILUWIH**

Jatiluwih is a favorite tourist destination in Bali famous with the beautiful rice terrace unfolding from the foot of mountain until the coastal side. It is one of places to visit in Bali with the beautiful view as according to its name from Jati and luwih, where Jati mean really and Luwih meaning especial, good, and beautiful or the equivalent.



#### **CANDI KUNING – FRUIT MARKET**

Located in Bedugul, Candi Kuning Market provides fresh fruits, vegetables, spices, and such exotic flowers as delicate orchids and roses, creating an array of wonderful colors. Spices include nutmeg, pepper, paprika and turmeric. A wide variety of fresh fruit and vegetables can be found here, as well as jerukbali (pomelo) and durian.



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## UBUD TOUR



Ubud Tour is the perfect combination between the cultural and nature tour which begin by visiting Tohpati village to see Batik making, then we'll drive you to the house of Stone Carving in Batubulan Village where you also able to see the process of making statues and stone carving. After visiting Batubulan we'll continue the trip to the waterfall in Kemenuh Village, Kemenuh Village is also the center of wood carving, along the road we will see the people carve a statue under the tree. From Kemenuh we'll firstly drive you to the Elephant Cave or known as Goa Gajah Temple one of ancient historical temples in Bali.

After relaxing and enjoying the historical sites, we'll continue our trip to Ceking Tegallalang, the place of best lush rice paddy terrace, great place for pampering your eyes and mind with its splendor green view, meet also the friendly smiling faces of farmers working in their rice fields. This tour will end in Ubud, you can look around in Ubud Village, the monkey forest, Ubud Palace and also visiting the traditional market before returning back to your hotel.

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#### **BATUBULAN**

The scenery around the waterfall Tegenungan quite beautiful, with green trees. Near the waterfall has been built with several shower baths from natural springs.



#### **WOOD CARVING AT KEMENUH**

Kemenuh is known as the village of wood carvers. All temples and palace architecture all over the island use wood and stone carvings. On visiting a temple or Balinese house, you will see the wood and stone carvings in form of demons with the aim of protecting the temple or house from any evil.



### **TEGALALANG – RICE TERRACE**

One of the most spectacular rice field terraces is Tegallalang area, just about 15 minutes drive outside of Ubud. Surrounding gorge full of rice fields has over the years attracted many photographers who captured its images on film and photos. Overtime Tegallalang rice fields became an attraction in itself.
